How familiar are you with Living Word's Care and Support Ministries? This group of ministries offers love, hope, healing and comfort to individuals who are lonely, home bound, or struggling with difficult life issues. The ministries are comprised of 6 separate volunteer groups, each created to be a "Living Expression of Jesus Christ in the World". The ministries are:

**Prayer Shawl Ministry** – Prayer shawl volunteers combine knitting and crocheting into a prayerful ministry that reaches out to those in need of comfort. The group meets twice a month to pray for recipients and share God's word in fellowship. Prayer shawls are symbolic of being wrapped in the embrace of a loving God to people who are suffering from an illness, loss, or hospitalization. Many prayers and blessings are woven into every shawl. No experience required! The Gathering Ministry - This ministry provides respite care for people suffering from memory loss, most commonly Alzheimer's disease. Volunteers host monthly Gatherings at Living Word on the third Thursday of the month where they visit, sing, play games, enjoy crafts, exercise, listen, share a meal, and experience God's love through our relationships with each other. **Common Ground** - "Common Ground" is a support group established for family caregivers that offers emotional support, encouragement, friendships and helpful tips about self-care and caregiving. Family caregivers caring for loved ones with Alzheimer's, or other related challenges due to aging, may join this monthly support group offered at the same time as The Gathering (the 3rd Thursday of the month at 10am) and led by Mona Fogt, a Living Word member and social worker.

**Care Team Ministry** - Care Team volunteers become the hands and feet of Jesus by reaching out and visiting church members, their extended family and friends who are homebound, living in assisted living/nursing homes or hospitalized. They offer the gifts of Holy Communion, comfort, fellowship, prayer and Christ's love. Team members meet bi-monthly to share experiences and pray for care recipients. **Grief Ministry** – Have you or someone you know suffered the loss of a loved one? Living Word's grief support group meets throughout the year to help participants process loss and restore hope by acquiring essential tools and support needed for any type of loss (old or new). A combination of prayer, community, program workbook and helpful educational materials are enhanced by shared group discussions. **Stephen Ministry** - Stephen Ministers provide highly trained, confidential, Christ-centered one-on-one care and support to people experiencing grief, death of a loved one, divorce, serious illness, job loss, loneliness, disability, relocation, and other life difficulties. Stephan ministers are carefully selected and complete 50 hours of training in addition to continuing education. Each Stephen Minister is carefully matched with a person of the same gender. 
### **CHILDREN**
