Not a summary, but a snapshot of your personal understanding about God at this point in your life

Please bring a written proposal of your faith statement project. The form is attached to this document—it includes: your name, your type of project, at least 3 sentences about why you are choosing to do a particular project and how it demonstrates your understanding of God.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR FAITH STATEMENT PROJECT**

- I. Your Faith Statement topic is "How do I share God?" Think about these prompts:
  - What do you believe about God and how do you share that?
  - What's one thing that sticks out in your mind from all three years of Confirmation & how does that help you share your faith?
  - How do your spiritual gifts help you share God?
  - How do you describe your relationship with God?
  - Give 1 or more personal experiences along with your thoughts
- II. Work with your parents about what type of project would be best for you
  - a. <u>Writing</u>—3-4 pages, 12 point font, 1 inch margins, single or double spaced. Your paper should include a topic sentence, a minimum of 5 paragraphs, Bible verses, and specific personal experiences
  - b. Music/Dance/Art/Poetry/ Scrapbook—in addition to your performance please include a 1-2 pages, 12 point font, 1 inch margins, single or spaced. In your writing include: Why you chose the song, the pictures, the art you made, etc. If you choose to express your faith statement through music/dance/art/poetry/ scrapbook you must present your song/dance /etc. at the confirmation banquet. All music and dance performances will be encouraged (but not required) to be presented during the confirmation Sunday worship, May 6.
  - c. All projects will be on display in the lobby on May 6 ©
- III. You are **required** to recite your memory verse and perform or share your project at the confirmation lunch **April 29, 12 2:00pm**. Attendance at this banquet is **mandatory** as this is our only opportunity to practice for Confirmation Sunday.
- IV. Confirmation Sunday, May 6, 2017 at the 11am worship service. Please arrive by 10:30am in the Life Center. Your family will want to go to the sanctuary at that time to get good seats. ©
