Education Endowment Grant Procedures:

- 1. All Grant requests must be typed or completed in ink on the appropriate Living Word Endowment Grant Application Form.
- 2. All applications must be consistent with the goals and objectives of the Living Word Endowment.
- 3. All Grant Applications must be made by or sponsored by a Living Word Member.
- 4. Grant Applications must be submitted to the Endowment Committee during the following time periods:
 - a. Education Endowment Grant applications will only be accepted during the month of July each year.
- 5. The Endowment Committee will analyze each request and Approve or Reject the Application within 30 days after the close of each application period. The Grantee will be advised via eMail.
- 6. For Approved Grant Requests, the Endowment Committee will provide a check / payment to the appropriate Individual / Ministry / Organization / Institution via Mail within 30 day of approval.

Education Priorities

Priority for Funding will be given to applications in the following order:

- 1. Provide funding for seminary attendee studying to be ordained as a Pastor or Chaplain.
- 2. Provide funding for student attending an ELCA affiliated college or university studying toward a religious related degree.
- 3. Provide funding for student attending an ELCA affiliated college or university studying toward a general degree.
- 4. Provide funding to lay persons serving in ELCA ministries that foster consideration of paths to seminary training (such as YAGM, Young Adults in Global Mission for ages 21-29).

Tips for Grant Seekers:

1. Before submitting any application, determine whether the Living Word Education Endowment goals and objectives are consistent with your grant request.

<u>The Goal of the Living Word Education Endowment</u> is to provide funding for educational goals of members in Living Word Lutheran Church (and/or family relatives of members) who are (a) pursuing training/ordination as an ELCA Pastor, or (b) attending an ELCA-affiliated College or University, or (c) serving in ELCA ministries/positions that foster consideration of paths toward seminary entry.

- 2. Provide a very clear description of why you are looking for funds.
- 3. Be creative, clear, concise, and accurate. Make the case for your proposal in your own unique way, but include precise information.
- 4. Emphasize what you will do. Spend more time describing your solution than the issue.
