
- Can you think of big change that happened in your life? A move, a new school, a new sibling?

Talk: Abraham and Sarah were surprised with the news that at such an old age, they were about to have a baby.

<u>Pray</u>: Say A prayer for Our City, Our State, Our Country and Our World. Thank God for loving us even when we make mistakes.



<u>Talk:</u>


- Do you ever get Jealous of anyone else in your family? Why?

• What makes a good leader?



• Are you afraid of talking in front of large crowds or of being made fun of?


<u>Pray</u>: Say A prayer for Our City, Our State, Our Country and Our World. Ask God to watch over all of our leaders in our world.

<u>Pray</u>: Say A prayer for Our City, Our State, Our Country and Our World. Ask God to bring Joy to those who are sad.




Talk: Sometimes listening is Hard.

<u>Share</u>: Gather as a Family and share highs and lows for the day/week. What did you learn this week? What are you looking forward to this upcoming week?


• Can you think of a time when your family did something one way and someone wanted to try a new and different way of doing it?

Learn: The Reformation began with a German monk named Martin Luther who did not like some things about how the Catholic Church was operating. Back then the Bible was only available in a language that most people could not read. The people that could read it were able to interpret it however they wanted and no one knew if it was right or wrong. Luther wanted everyone to be able to read God's Word. He worked on translating the Bible into a language that everyone could do better.

Talk: Reformation means changing things for the better.

- As a Family talk about the rules you have around your house and the way you communicate with each other.
- Are there ways you can do things differently and more effectively?

<u>Pray</u>: Say A prayer for Our City, Our State, Our Country and Our World. Say a prayer for those who lead the Church, at Living Word and around the World.







Talk: David was young but knew God would take care of him and he trusted him very much.


- Is it surprising to see a young person doing amazing things?

- Is there a time you can think of when you spoke up for someone else to help them?
- What about when someone else stood up for you?

<u>Read</u>: When Esther was young she went to live with her cousin in the Kings Palace. Her and her cousin were Jewish and saw other Jewish people being mistreated. **Read the Story of Esther to see what she did to help the other people in her community.**


<u>Talk</u>: Esther and Mordecai could have been hurt by standing up for what they knew was right. In the end the king chose their side and helped their people.

• Talk about stories that you know of people who spoke up for those who were hurting or unable to speak for themselves.

• What are you scared of? Spiders, The Dark, being alone?


• Why do you think you are afraid of this?
